## High Altitude Balloon Pushed Along By Jetstream

® WB6TOU-11 continues to report in this morning, its speed increased overnight being swept along by a robust upper altitude Jetstream. Telemetry reports put the balloons speed at over 75mph, altitude is stable at $41,142 \mathrm{ft}$. It's track is heading out to the Gulf Of Saint Lawrence, with a possible last landfall of St. John's before reaching the vastness of the Atlantic Ocean.
St. John's Newfoundland was the last landfall of daring aviator Charles Lindbergh in his 1927 non-stop flight to Paris.
