- (5) Welcome and Opening by President, Ken Sanders Pledge Agenda Changes? None
- ® Reading of minutes by Secretary Steve Dexter, AA6AQ He's resigned. Needs replacement. Two members expressed willingness to take over Secretary position: K6MAB (Miriam) and NV6V. After some discussion, a vote was taken and NV6V was elected.
 - 5 President & Repeater Operator Report Ken Sanders, AE6LA
 - a. Fowler Relocation to La Rau Communications Fowler Site Repeater was moved on 2-6-16 to LaRue site. AE6LA (Ken) received a nasty cut but is OK now. Site is shared with several other companies. Autopatch is up. Crew has been working to improve the antenna. Some advice was offered by K6FRC (Paul) and he feels our VHF antenna should be OK to place on top of the 110'(+) tower. AE6LA will be seeking design advice from KC6QID (Mike), WS6P (Sam), KK6ZQG (Draza) and WA6ZTY(Mike), who will chair the group. Hoping to get APRS and Winlink equipment in place soon. AE6LA and WA6ZTY will schedule a meeting.
 - b. Possible Alternate Locations for Fowler Equipment Some discussion was had regarding Quiggs Mountain. No cost estimate yet. Possible field test from this site on an upcoming Monday Night Net.
 - c. Fowler 5.17, 4.39, 4.31, remote base, EchoLink and phone patch Operations WS6P needs the address of the LaRue site to configure the Ooma telephone provider so calls from the site report correctly to authorities.
 - d. Reba 4.39, 441.0375 Operations operational, but no hard data to confirm. APRS is operating as evidenced by several reports.
 - e. Blue Lake Springs Arnold UHF site going up on test pair 441.875 Will be useful for SAR, local (Arnold area) users and as a link to Fowler. Some funding may be needed to get it operational. Crystals are needed. NV6V asked if a similar UHF repeater might work in Valley Springs on the same frequency pair. AE6LA and WA6ZTY think it is feasible.
 - f. Arnold Preparedness Fair May 7 at Independence Hall CARS Inc. has been invited. AE6LA will be representing the club there to promote Amateur Radio and a possible Ham Cram on 5-28-16.

 - a. Financial Report Current bank balance: \$2,717.00.

 - d. Dues and budget recommendations Yearly Budget analysis shows that projected expenses for the coming year will be approximately \$2,676.00. With the current dues structure, if all members that are due in July of this year paid, the income would be \$1,706.00.
