With the PG&E's PSPS it was a busy month, RACES was not active by OES. Speaking of OES, Chad Cossey resigned as OES coordinator, he was our main contact into OES. I wish him good luck on his new assignment. We are looking for some operators that can do the California Emergency Services Net. The net is Monday nights and Wednesday mornings, if you are interested in this please contact me.

ARES

We had 4 Public Safety Power Shutdowns in October. We had approximately 288 hours without power in the county. I used ARES Connect to pass on information to all ARES members as well to the SJV Section EC and Asst. EC. During these PSPS I found some vulnerability's in the W6WPT repeater in West Point. With the Cooperation from West Point Fire CERT those issues we resolved within a week of their discovery. The N6FRG repeater also showed some vulnerability, it was down during the PSPS. Being the main repeater for the county this is a major issue. I hope that the CARS repeater committee will look into these vulnerabilities.

I would also encourage everyone to program their radio to include using the repeater output as a simplex channel. Setting 145.170 MHz without an offset or a tone will work.

Mike, N6AXQ, along with others did a great job doing a simplex net on 10/28, as the repeater was offline due to the PSPS. PSPS looks to be the norm going forward according to the PG&E personnel that I spoke to during the PSPS. I would strongly suggest that every ARES as well as CARS member's look into having a battery backup base station, so you can be in contact with other during these PSPS.

During a PSPS please monitor the N6FRG and/or the W6WPT repeater; this can be the best way to get info. Also please keep your radio go bag ready, as we may be needed to deploy very quickly.
