# **Calaveras Amateur Radio Society (CARS)**

## Minutes for Quarterly General Meeting, November 11th, 2021, 18:30

Meeting Location: Round Table Pizza, Angels Camp, CA

Note: Regular meeting room was occupied. W6AJW making arrangements to reserve room for future meetings.

### 1) Meeting called to order

- a) Welcome by club president, Steve, W6RXK
- b) Pledge of allegiance said by all
- c) Self-introductions by all (guest visitor: Helen Yost, KM6ELE)
- d) Mark, N6IV, volunteered to take meeting minutes in Jacks absence.
- 2) Reading of Minutes from last meeting by Steve, W6RXK. Minutes were approved as read.
- 3) Treasurer's Report by Ken, AE6LA, (see attached reports)

Summary: We have \$5,000+ in our account, we are doing well Membership as-is now at 71, down from 98. Some members have moved away, others have decided not to rejoin (see current list on website).

- 4) Net Report by Mark, N6IV. None at meeting. Here are post meeting stats:
  - a) The average number of club member check-ins for Sept. and Oct. was 25, with a range of 22 to 31.
  - b) Regular visitor check-ins averaged 12 per week, with a range of 8 to 14.

### 5) Repeater Report presented by Ken, AE6LA

- a) Ken and Mike, WA6ZTY, visited Fowler site with a spectrum analyzer and retuned the duplexers. Resulting in much improved repeater performance.
- b) Fowler repeater is commercial quality and is about 2 years old. Life expectancy is about 10-20 years. A high gain vertical favoring our direction was installed by club member, James Bishop, KM6AXN.
- c) Fowler site has a back-up generator (not known if working at the moment). The summit level repeater is solar powered and also has a back-up. The club also has a back-up repeater at Ken's house. The club has 3 repeater sites; Fowler VHF, Summit Level UHF, and Reba UHF.
- 6) Breakfast Report. Dee, KM6ELF encouraged members to continue to attend the club breakfasts and encourages club officers to attend if possible. The CARS Christmas breakfast will be held at the Murphy's Hotel Dec. 4, at 10am Saturday morning. Everyone is invited and many members did a show of hands to express their desire to attend.
- 7) Web Master's Report. There was not a report given since Andy, NV6V, was not present.
- 8) Public Information Officer Report by Mike, WB6USJ.

Mike reported that the Great California Shake Out held Oct 12, 2021 was a success. Many counties

checked in reporting their simulated emergencies that arose from an earthquake.

- 9) ARES/RACES Report: A report from Sam, W6SP, Calaveras County EC, was submitted (see attached).
- **10) Old Business.** Chuck, W6AJW, and Al, KF6OBM, reported on the Emergency Trailer. They have been working on it as weather permits. New elastomeric coating to roof was applied and interior work continues. Club members are invited to join in their effort.

### 11) New Business.

- a) Elections for President, Secretary, and Public Information Officer were completed. Steve, W6RXK, for President; Jack, W6JAK, for Secretary; and Mike, KB6USJ, for Public Information Officer were all elected and sworn into office.
- b) Mike, N6AXQ, brought up discrepancies in the CARS By-Laws. Noting that the term "Quarterly meetings" which appear throughout the document is not being followed. The annual dues clause needs to be expanded to define grace periods for payment and deadlines. The topic of club insurance policies being in effect and coverage concerns were also mentioned.
- c) A vote was taken to establish a By-Laws committee. Dee, KM6ELF, Chuck, W6AWJ, Steve, W6RXK, and Mike, KB6USJ-N6AXQ volunteered to be on the committee which will review changes if needed and present them to the club. This will occur after Jan 1, 2022.
- d) The Ride and Walk 4 Art will be held again in 2022 and several members showed willingness to help out during the event.
