Minutes for Quarterly General Meeting, March 9th, 2022, 18:30 Meeting Location: Round Table Pizza, Angels Camp, CA

1) Meeting called to order

- a) Welcome by club president, Steve, W6RXK
- b) Pledge of allegiance led by Mark, N6IV
- c) Self-introductions by all: new members Chris, KF6NFW, and Beth, KD7KNF, Robinson
- 2) Reading of Minutes by Jack, W6JAK. The minutes were approved as read.
- 3) Treasurer's Report by Ken, AE6LA (see attached reports).
 - a) Ken stated the reporting period started with \$6448 and ended with \$6011 (rounded). The reduced balance is typical for this time of year because of lack of dues payments.
 - b) Dues paid now are good through June 2024.
 - c) A \$500 donation was received from the Arnold Rim Trail Association (ARTA)Pacific Trail Runs. However, the check was post-dated and bounced causing the club to incur a \$15 returned check fee. A replacement check for \$515 will be sent by the ARTAPacific Trail Runs.
 - d) There are a total of 79 active members, 47 of which are also ARRL members.
 - e) The second to last transaction entry of the financial report is regarding a \$20 cash received for hats which required Ken to write a check for depositing. The last transaction entry is regarding polyphasers which should not have been in the report.

4) Monday Night Net Report by Mark, N6IV.

- a) For January, the average member of check-ins was 30 with a range of 27 to 32. Guest check-ins averaged 8, with a range of 6 to 10.
- b) For February, the average member of check-ins was 28 with a range of 24 to 31. Guest check-ins averaged 10, with a range of 8 to 12.

5) Repeater Report presented by Ken, AE6LA.

- a) Fowler Peak Repeater: No news has been received from Knox La Rue regarding a replacement tower. The repeater is currently running on the APRS antenna. The remote base and repeater are functional.
- b) Summit Level Repeater: the remote base is not working so there is no link to Fowler Peak. The APRS is working well. The Summit site has several repeaters in operations including Calaveras Command (Fire), CCSAR, the club UHF repeater, and the APRS digipeater.
- c) Reba Mountain Repeater: No status is available from Ken due to weather. Mike, WA6ZTY, said the repeater was working as of three weeks ago.

6) Breakfast Report presented by Nancy, KG6AWT.

- a) There was a total of seven attendees. Good conversations were enjoyed by all.
- b) The next breakfast is scheduled for April 1st and the Murphys Hotel.

Andy sent out an email to the membership regarding a list of weather station brands and models compatible with the site's new weather reporting capability. Andy currently has his weather station reporting information, but no one else has provided reporting information from their station. Once other stations are participating, Andy may show their locations on a map.
- 8) Public Information Officer Report was presented by Mike, KB6USJ.
 - a) The Pico balloon project with Mountain Oak School has been delayed. The launch is expected to occur later in April. The launch will occur in Lodi and Mike will send out an email with the location and date so members can attend.
 - b) The first amateur radio class at Mountain Oak School is scheduled for March 20th with a second session scheduled for March 27th. About a dozen students are expected to attend.
- 9) ARES/RACES Report. A report provided by Sam, WS6P, was read by Jack, W6JAK (see attached). Chris, KF6NFW, expressed interest in joining Calaveras County ARES and provided his email to Jack for informing Sam.

10) Old Business.

- a) Al, KF6OBM, worked on the club's emergency trailer by tagging the electrical wires. Progress on the trailer has been slow due to the weather and with Chuck, W6AJW, being sick.
- b) There is no change to the status on updating the club's bylaws.
- c) Status on the club's VE program was discussed. Chris, KF6NFW, Mike, KB6USJ, and Jack, W6JAK, have VE certificates but there is no one with a required Extra Class license. Jack stated he is currently studying to take the Extra Class exam.
