Minutes for Quarterly General Meeting, May 9th, 2024, 18:30 Meeting Location: Round Table Pizza, Angels Camp, CA

1) Meeting called to order:

- a) Welcome by club president, Steve, W6RXK;
- b) Pledge of allegiance led by Mark, N6IV;
- c) Self-introductions by all.
- 2) Presentation on linked repeaters by Mark, N6ARP: Mark provided an informative presentation on repeater networks using analog links. The networks he covered included TCARES, CARLA, WIN System, CONDOR, Salinas Valley Repeater Group, and MCARG. His presentation will be made available on the CARS website.
- 3) Reading of Minutes by Jack, W6JAK. The minutes were approved as read.
- 4) Treasurer's Report by Ken, AE6LA (see attached report):
 - a) Membership dues are due June 30th;
 - b) The club's account balance is \$4,436.85. The upgrade of the Mount Reba repeater was the major expense;
 - c) Rob Williams of the Calaveras Arts Council sent a thank you card for the club's support at their last event;
 - d) Equipment sales are a big source of income for the club. Contact Steve, W6RXK, to donate equipment.
- 5) Monday Night Net Report by Mark, N6IV.
 - a) The average number of member of check-ins for the past two months was 35 with a range of 24 to 41;
 - b) Guest check-ins averaged 8, with a range of 4 to 10;
 - c) This activity is similar to the previous period.
- 6) **Repeater Report** presented by Ken, AE6LA.
 - a) The Reba upgrade is nearly functional but requires tuning which must be done by Mike, WA6ZTY. The antenna will be pointed to the Hawkins repeater for the Death Ride. The repeater can be linked to the Dodge Ridge repeater for connecting to the TCARES system.
 - b) Fowler repeater: We are still waiting for Knox LaRue to finish the new tower. Knox has now said he does not have an antenna to give to the club, so we will have to obtain one. Mike, N6AXQ, asked what caused the interference during the April 29th net. Ken said it could not be determined and that it was beyond our control since it came from an external source.
 - c) Summit Level repeater: no change to the repeater status. Ken has a GMRS repeater installed at the site to support the local GMRS group. The repeater does not have an indentifier;
 - d) A comms trailer has been obtain for SAR. Ken has a portable repeater which could be installed on the trailer when needed. Ken is also working on Project Life Saver with SAR which tracks people with dementia.

- 7) Breakfast Report presented by Lynn, AC6CY (Dee, KM6ELF, was not at the breakfast). Only three people attended the breakfast, probably due to bad weather. Lynn encouraged people to attend the breakfast meetings.
- 8) Web Master's Report. Andy, NV6V, was not in attendance to provide a report.
- 9) Public Information Officer Report. Presented by Mike, KB6USJ:
 - a) June will be a very busy month with several special events including, Museum Ships Weekend, ARRL VHF contest, Kids Day, and Field Day;
 - b) Mike, KB6USJ, Walt, K6WGY, Mark, N6IV, and others will be conducting Field Day operations in Avery starting at 9:00 AM on the 22nd;
 - c) The KB6USJ balloon is still orbiting the globe. Next Friday will be the one year anniversary of the launch.
- **10) ARES/RACES Report.** A report provided by Sam, WS6P, was presented by Jack, W6JAK (see attached).

11) New Business.

a) Steve, AE6LA, met with Knox LaRue to look at an antenna that is being donated to the club. The antenna is commercial grade but needs refurbishment. Mike, WA6ZTY, gave Steve information on three types of antennas, all being expensive. Bill Holmes has a collinear antenna he's willing to donate to the club. A discussion ensued and it was agreed that club members will drive to Bill's home in Nevada to get his antenna. Knox is planning on finishing the tower soon.

- a) New tires were installed on the club's trailer which is now at KF6OBM's location. Al is continuing to work on the wiring;
- b) Work on updating the bylaws are still in progress.
