Calaveras Amateur Radio Society (CARS)

Minutes for Quarterly General Meeting, Nov. 14th, 2024, 18:30 Meeting Location: Round Table Pizza, Angels Camp, CA

1) Meeting called to order:

- a) Welcome by club president, Steve, W6RXK;
- b) Pledge of allegiance led by Ken, AE6LA;
- c) Self-introductions by all, including new members Marlin, N6MIV, and Natasha, K06FTY.
- 2) Reading of Minutes by Jack, W6JAK. The minutes were approved as read upon a motion by Mark, N6IV.
- 3) Treasurer's Report by Ken, AE6LA (see attached report):
 - a) The banking summary showed a beginning balance of \$5,893.53 and an ending balance of \$5,296.36. Expenses exceeded income by \$597.17;
 - b) Expenses included reimbursing Steve, W6RXK, \$187.86 for picnic expenditures and a \$200 donation to Vine and Branch church for the use of their facility;
 - c) Steve stated that the Vine and Branch pastor was very appreciative of how clean we left the facility. Steve then asked for a show of hands of those who would like to have next year's picnic at Vine and Branch most attendees approved.

4) Monday Night Net Report by Mark, N6IV.

- a) The average number of member of check-ins for the past two months was 33 with a range of 25 to 39;
- b) Guest check-ins averaged 7, with a range of 4 to 14;
- c) Mike, KB6USJ, mentioned that the 40M net organized by K1VHR is averaging 10 to 12 check-ins. The net occurs Monday mornings at 9:00 AM on 7.195 MHz.

5) Repeater Report presented by Ken, AE6LA.

- a) Fowler Peak repeater: Mark, N6ARP, worked with Ken on the All Star node. It is plugged into the repeater but is not operational. The repeater antenna system has poor SWR but the circulator diverts the reflected power to the dummy load. The system is working well despite the SWR issue.
- b) Summit Level repeater: Ken, Mike, WA6ZTY, Jerry, KD6GLQ, and Mark, N6ARP, went to the site to perform maintenance. Ken fixed a problem with the audio not being transmitted by reconnecting the radio. Mike added a third battery to the backup power system. He also reset the camera that Cal Fire took down from the tower. The camera is still not working so Mike will continue to do troubleshooting. Once it is back in operation, Mike will provide the password to members for using the camera remotely.
- c) Reba/Bear Valley repeater: Ken made three trips to the site. He removed the Kenwood repeater for Mike to work on. Mike adjusted the tuned circuit and the sensitivity improved dramatically. He also installed a pre-amp but it overloaded the receiver. Inserting a filter improved the isolation and the system is now working well. The commercial antenna is not working as well as the Diamond X-50 it replaced. The antennas will be swapped at a later date.

- 6) Breakfast Report presented by Dee, KM6ELF. Thirty two people have signed up for the Christmas Breakfast at the Murphys Hotel. The breakfast will be at 10:00 AM on December 7th. There will be two other large groups at the same time. Contact Dee if you want to attend.
- 7) Web Master's Report. Andy, NV6V, was not present at the meeting. Mike, KB6USJ, stated he has been posting photos of recent events. Ken, AE6LA, stated the roster has been updated on the site and it can be accessed by members using the password.
- 8) Public Information Officer Report presented by Mike, KB6USJ. Mike mentioned the January calendar of events and that he has been considering organizing a special events station such as for the Frog Jump or Mark Twain's birthday. He also mentioned the possibility of a road trip to the KPH historical station in Bolinas, CA. Ken, AE6LA, said that the two bicycle events we usually support have been terminated. The Arnold Rim Trail run may be held again next year.
- 9) ARES/RACES Report. Jack, W6JAK, read the report provided by Sam, WS6P (see attached).
- **10) New Business.** Nominations for treasurer and vice president were discussed. Current candidaters are Mark, N6ARP, for treasurer and Dee, KM6ELF, for Vice Presdent. Chuck, W6AJW, made a motion that nominations be closed and a vote be taken. The motion was approved and the vote for Dee and Mark was unanimous. Mark and Dee will begin their terms in January.

11) Old Business.

- a) Al, KF6OBM, obtained new carpet and padding for the club trailer. He will be working the brake wiring next;
- b) The update to the bylaws will be discussed at the next meeting. Changes have been made and Steve, W6RXK, would lke to show where the changes were done. Jack, W6JAK, offered to do a document compare in Microsoft Word which will easily highlight the changes. Steve said he would send Jack the files.

12) Round Table:

- a) A Hallicrafters HT-9 radio donated my Mike, KB6USJ, is available for purchase. Proceeds will go to the club.
- b) The Lodi club has a packet station working on Bear Mountain. It is operating on 145.05 MHz with a node name of N6SJV-4.
- c) Chuck made a motion for the club to send \$100 to the Lodi club as a donation for the use of their repeater. The motion was approved.
